Family Fish Derby Rules and Regulations

Each participant in the derby:

1. Must have a valid Ontario fishing licence.
2. May enter any species of fish caught in the waters of Eagle Lake, Ontario caught by hook and line and retrieved and caught by net by rod and reel in a legal manner as designated by the Province of Ontario MNR Recreational Fishing Regulations Summary.
3. Anyone under the age of 12 will be registered as a youth. Anyone 12 or older must register as an adult.
4. Must be fishing with one other derby participant in the boat. In the case of shore fishing the witness must be in immediate company of the contestant that caught the fish.
5. Must enter the fish whole, not gaffed, gutted or snagged and winners will be determined by the weight of the fish only.
6. The largest fish caught regardless of species has a first place finish.
7. Is entitled to only one prize. No participants may win more than one of the prizes, although contestants may enter more than one fish.
8. Agrees that the decision of the judges will be final and non reviewable in any form. In the event of a tie, the person who enters the first fish according to the time recorded on the fish entry form will be the winner. The second or subsequent fish, entered at the same weight, will assume the next lowest division position, and so on, until all the positions are filled. If two or more fish of identical weight are entered at the same time, a toss of the coin shall determine the winner and the loser will assume the next lower position in the division.
9. Agrees that the weigh master must weigh in all fish entered in the derby at the weigh station on the day caught. Agrees that the fish derby begins at 7:00AM and all fish must be weighed in by 4:00PM.
