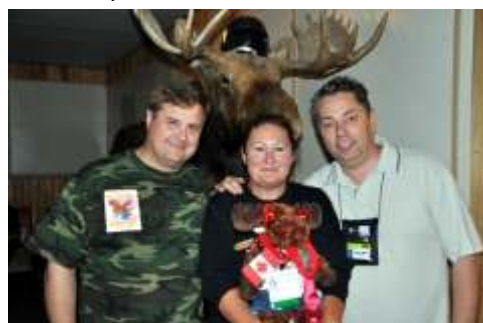

Risk Management

Hello fellow Kin.

I have been requested to give some information on how to complete the T2 Corporate Tax return, where to send it and to notify everyone of the DEC 31st deadline.

Let's start with the easy information – where to send the return – For our District the address is;
Canada Tax Centre
14000 Stn Main
Winnipeg, MB
R3C3M2

Next deadline – all corporate returns must be filed by December 31, 2009. This means at least post marked by that date – better yet in Canada Revenue's possession.

Now for the fun. There is an example on Kin Canada's website on a Short return T2 which is what I believe everyone should be able to file. This is a good example with the information we need to provide. Last year most clubs received a BN number (business number) that CRA assigned for us to use as our identification number. If you can not locate this number or not sure if it is correct – I have been instructed by Melanie at HQ to still file the return, just attach a letter stating that you are filing the return but are unsure of the BN number that may have been assigned from CRA. This will keep your club in compliance with CRA. If you would like a little more information you can go to cra.gc.on.ca website and click on Businesses/Corporations/Corporate Tax Return/T2 Short Return/t2short-08e.pdf. This will give you a short description of the return with the T2 and schedules. Most clubs will not need the Schedule 8 or Schedule 50. You will need Schedule T2SCH546.

Once again I will reiterate if you need anything, help, a shoulder to cry on or just to vent, please give me a call or email and I will be there to assist you in any means I can. Remember re-boot does not mean actually kicking your computer. I know this does not work from actual experience. Broken toes and broken computer not good!
